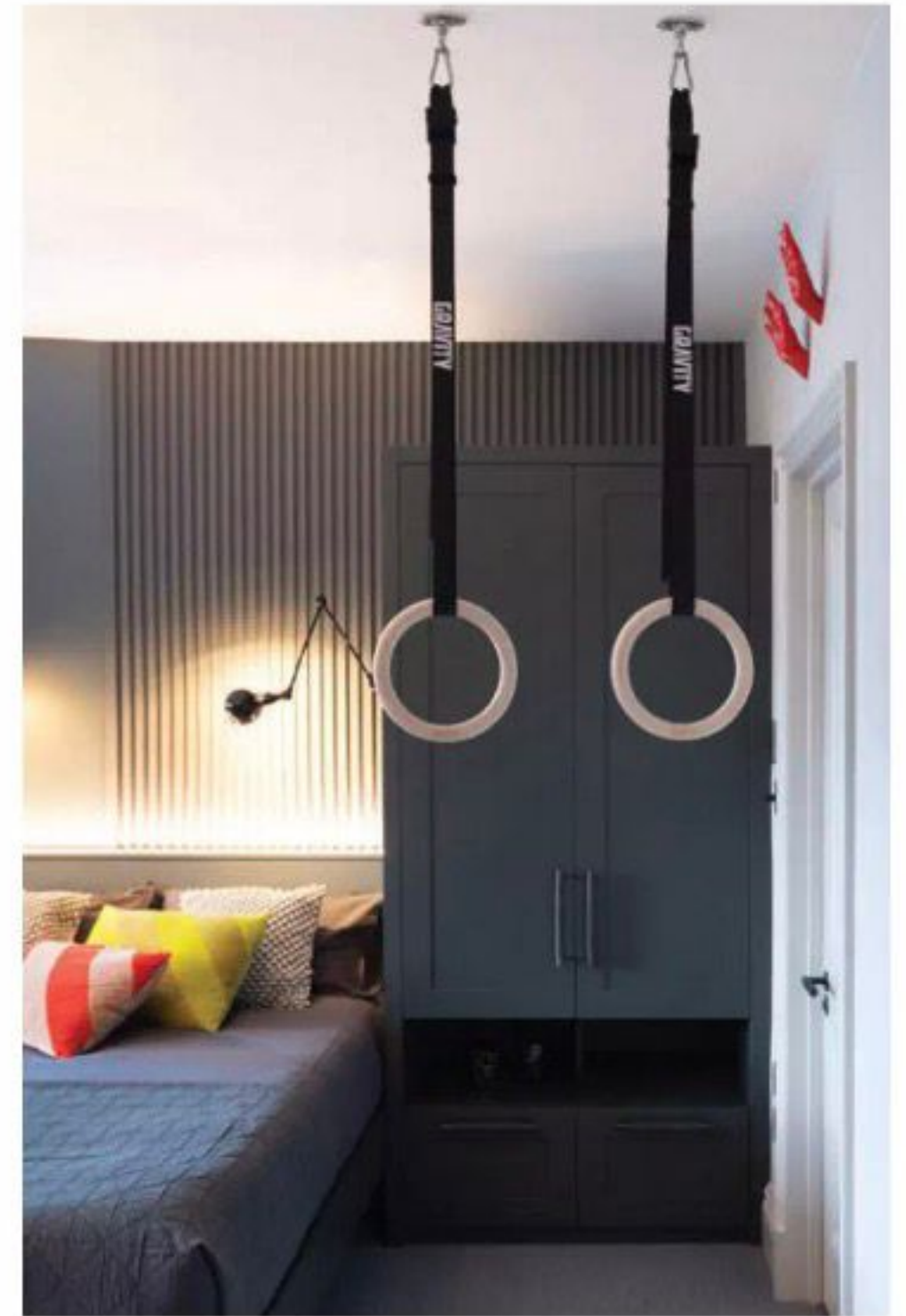


MAKE TIME TO PLAY
